Dallas, on 6/3 and 4/64, symbols on photograph identified as follows:
"B" - is place where 1958 black over white, tudor Chevrolet first
observed by COLDMAN;
"G" - is alley entrance into Norman Church parking lot, and which alley
entrance is obscured from COLDMAN'S vision due to stockade fence
around garbage cans.
"2" - is place where unknown white male, No. 2, first observed by COLDMAN.
