SASSA ADVISED LEGAT JUNE 2 THAT AUTHOR OF THE ARTICLE, GLENN CLARK TROELSTRUP, BASED ARTICLE ON IMPORMAL GROUP DISCUSSION HELD APRIL 24 LAST IN TOKYO. LEETING WAS ENTIRELY IN JAPANESE LANGUAGE, IN WHICH TROELSTRUP HAS IMPERFECT KNOWLEDGE, AND NO NOTES WERE TAKEN BY TROELSTRUP. SASSA HAS INTERVIEWED TROELSTRUP JUNE 2 OBTAIN-ING SIGNED ADMISSION OF SEVERAL INACCURACIES. SASSA WILL RE-INTERVIEW TROELSTRUP JULIE 3 TO OBTAIN SPECIFIC ADMISSIONS THAT ALL REFERENCES TO FBI WERE INACCURATE. LEGAT WILL NOT PERSON-ALLY INTERVIEW TROELSTRUP UNLESS BUREAU INSTRUCTS.
