RELATIONS WITH NATIONAL POLICE AGENCY OF JAPAN. JUNE 8 ISSUE OF "U.S. NEWS AND WORLD REPORT" MAGAZINE, PAGES 38 - 39, CARRIES ARTICLE TITLED "NEW LIGHT ON THE ASSASSINATION: A SECRET AGENT'S STORY" ATTRIBUTING NUMEROUS COMMENTS CONCERNING THE ASSASSINATION AND REFERENCES TO FBI TO ATSUYUKI SASSA, JAPANESE POLICE SUPERINTENDENT WHO RECENTLY VISITED BUREAU, SECRET SERVICE, AND DALLAS POLICE ON OFFICIAL STUDY MISSION. SASSA ADVISED LEGAT JUNE 2 THAT AUTHOR OF THE ARTICLE, GLENN CLARK TROELSTRUP, BASED ARTICLE ON INFORMAL GROUP DISCUSSION HELD APRIL 24 LAST IN TOKYO. MEETING WAS ENTIRELY IN JAPANESE LANGUAGE, IN WHICH TROELSTRUP HAS IMPERFECT KNOWLEDGE, AND NO NOTES WERE TAKEN BY TROELSTRUP. SASSA HAS INTERVIEWED TROELSTRUP JUNE 2 OBTAINING SIGNED ADMISSION OF SEVERAL INACCURACIES. SASSA WILL RE-INTERVIEW TROELSTRUP JUNE 3 TO OBTAIN SPECIFIC ADMISSIONS THAT ALL REFERENCES TO FBI WERE INACCURATE. LEGAT WILL NOT PERSONALLY INTERVIEW TROELSTRUP UNLESS BUREAU INSTRUCTS. FOR BUREAU INFORMATION EMBASSY RECORDS REFLECT TROELSTRUP BORN JULY 3, 1930 AT HINSDALE, ILLINOIS. HE WAS MARRIED ON SEPTEMBER 1, 1960, AT TOKYO TO KYOKO BABA, A JAPANESE NATIONAL. LEGAT INDICES NEGATIVE ON TROELSTRUP. LETTER FOLLOWS.
