NOTE:

Since the assassination we have received numerous complaints relating to individuals other than Lee Harvey Oswald. These complaints generally relate to remarks and threats allegedly made by individuals concerning their feelings about President Kennedy, other officials and the policies of the administration. The complaints are initiated by cranks, mental cases and patriotic citizens. Some of these people pose a possible threat to the President and other high officials and we insure appropriate dissemination is made. This will be the fourth such report disseminated to the President's Commission. A copy will be disseminated to the U. S. Secret Service separately. The enclosed report has been reviewed by Mr. Belmont, Malley and appropriate Bureau supervisory personnel.
