John Havens of the IGA Store Hugoton, Kansas, discovered in cash receipts the dollar bill upon which was written "I'm going to kill the president Nov. 15, 1963." There was no indication as to what disposition was made of this bill and Kansas City was instructed to determine if the bill was picked up and if not submit it to the Laboratory. Kansas City advised 6-26-64, the bill was obtained by Secret Service and they are conducting investigation.
