REF: Excerpts of Citizenship and Temper, August 13, 1961

In preparation for the possible receipt of Soviet exit visas for American citizen Lee H. (L.H.) and his Soviet wife, a security advisory opinion is hereby requested in her case. Also transmitted is Mr. Oswald's petition for correct status for his wife. A favorable security opinion and approval of the petition is recommended together with a letter of the sanctions imposed by Section 213(e) of the Act. The pertinent data regarding Mrs. Oswald are given below:

Born: July 17, 1931, Volgograd (Volgogradsk Oblast)

Parents: Decedent. Mother's second husband, Alexei Ivanovich MEDVEDOV, residing in Vologda, Vologda Oblast.

Lived with her mother in Vologda and after her father's death. Her mother was employed in a hospital laboratory. Graduated from Middle School No. 37L, Leningrad, 1955. Graduated from Leningrad Technical Institute, Leningrad, 1959. Presently resides in Minsk with her son and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Proshchonok at Apartment 20, No. 12 Kalinin Street, Minsk.

Married to Lee Harvey Oswald on April 30, 1961, in Minsk. Now residing with husband at Apartment 20, No. 1 Kalinin Street, Minsk.

She is employed as a laboratory assistant in the Filatovskaya Hospital, Minsk. In connection with her employment and her professional training, she has been a member of the Lenin Trade Union for Medical Workers since 1957. Such membership is specifically considered to be involuntary under Section 213(e)(3)(C)(ii) of the Act.
