ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, DALLAS, TEXA

An envelope was received in my office on June 30, 1964, addressed to the Bureau, care of Leo Gauthier. The envelope was from Mr. Robert H. West, County Surveyor, Dallas, Texas, whose firm handled extensive measurements and mathematical calculations on Nay 24, 1964, in line with detailed measurements being made at the request of the President's Commission and under the supervision of J. Lee Rankin, Norman Redlich, and Arlen Specter of the President's Commission. Enclosed in the envelope was a bill in the amount of \$830.00.

Inasmuch as this work was arranged for at the specific request of the President's Commission and for their use, I called Mrs. Eide, Mr. Rankin's secretary and advised her of the receipt of this bill and told her that it was being delivered to the President's Commission for handling by the Commission.
