On 7/2/64, Mr. J. Lee Rankin, General Counsel of the President's Commission, requested SA's Lyndal Shaneyfelt and Robert A. Frazier be present at a Commission hearing beginning at 2:00 p.m., 7/2/64. He stated that Mr. Mark Lane, who at one time conducted investigations concerning the shooting of Lee Harvey Oswald at the request of his mother, Mrs. Marguerite Oswald, was appearing to testify. Mr. Rankin desired that SA's Shaneyfelt and Frazier be available to answer any questions which might arise concerning the assassination rifle and photographs of it which had appeared in news media.

During the hearing at which Chief Justice Earl Warren and Representative Gerald R. Ford (Rep. - Mich.) were present, the assassination rifle was shown to Mr. Lane; however, no questions concerning the rifle or photographs of it arose and it was not necessary for either Mr. Frazier or Mr. Shaneyfelt to testify.

Mr. Lane's testimony consisted of his refusal to answer any questions concerning the investigation which he had conducted. In his refusal he claimed either a client-attorney relationship or claimed it would violate his word of honor promise to a confidential source of information.
