Houston by airtel 7-16-64, furnished a letterhead memorandum concerning an interview with Ruby Victoria who sent a telegram to the Houston Office relating to a mail sack murder in LaGrange, Texas. When interviewed, Ruby Victoria made various allegations regarding murders and other information relating to her which leads one to conclude she is mentally deranged. There is no indication she had any information relating to the assassination.
