Your attention is specifically directed to paragraph two page 1, paragraph three page 1, and paragraph 1 page 2 of this letter regarding the time element and discrepancy of time. It appears the discrepancy which appears on page 19 of your letterhead memorandum dated Earch 23, 1964, could have appeared in the transcript you received from the Dallas PD.

Rogarding paragraph 1 rage 2 concerning a time element variation of two minutes from 1:16 p.m. to 1:18 p.m. when the report regarding the shooting of a police officer was put out or Dallas PD channels one and two, Consideration should be given by Dallas as to jurnishing the physical setup of the Dallas PD relating to radio communications. However, it seems important that this point should be clarified.

For your information the Commission's original letter dated Earch 3, 1964, requesting the radio transmissions, they specifically desired only a transcript of radio transmissions from 12:20 p.m., 11/22/63, to 6 p.m., 11/24/63. However, it appears your office was furnished the transcript starting at the control and substantial and sub 10 a.m. which was reported and subsequently included the pertinent period of time involved that the Commission was concerned with.

When you obtain the original tapes of the radio broadcast as requested by the President's Commission, prepare and submit a letterhead memorandum and insure meticulous accuracy to clarify. and resolve questions raised by the Cormission.

NOTE

A letter from the Commission dated July 16, 1964 requested we obtain the original tapes of radio transmissions from the Dalles PD and furnish a transcipt of radio transmissions for the 2 specific period of time from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Friday, November 22, 1963, and from 10 s.m. to 2 p.m. on Sunday, November 24, 1963. We have previously furnished the Commission a LHM regarding this matter, however, in their original request desired transmissions from a period of 12:20 p.m. on November 22 to 6 p.m. November 24, 1963, relating to the Assassination of President Kennedy, the murder of police officer J. D. Tippit, and movements of Lee Harvey Oswald to the Dallas County Jail. Referenced DL airtel indicated the transcripts were furnished to us by the DL PD and there was no indication we reviewed the original tapes which could account for

discrepancies in time reporting as indicated. DL has been instructed to completely resolve these minural. This case is on the Director's specials List.
