MemorandumASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY 11/22/63, DALLAS, TEXAS On June 26, 1964, Inspector Thomas J. Kelley of the Secret Service asked SA Lyndal L. Shaneyfelt whether or not they could obtain copies of the films made during the re-enactment of the assassination in Dallas, Texas, on May 24, 1964. Inspector Kelley and his staff were an integral part of the re-enactment although the films were actually made by FBI personnel. The Laboratory knows of no reason why the re-enactment films should not be given to Secret Service.
