ABOUT 12:31 P.M. Nov 22, 1963, Pres. John F. Kennedy and Sen. John Connally were shot while riding in parade in the 400 block of Elm Street heading west. Shots were fired from southeast front window, top floor of Texas School Book Depository at 4th Elm Street, Dallas. Rifle and (1) one live shell in chamber and (2) three empty shells were found in building.

AT 2:00 P.M. Nov 22, 1963, a citizen reported to the Dallas Police that a Dallas Officer had been shot enroute to 400 West 10th St. Dallas, Texas. This was Patrolman J. J. Tippitt, Dallas Police Dept. The officer was taken to Methodist Hosp. by the Dallas M. Hughes Fire Home Amb. and was D.O.A. from multiple gunshot wounds. Judge Joe B. Arund, Jr., J.P., Pres. of Police ordered medico-legal autopsy at Parkland Mem. Hosp., Dallas. Dr. EARL F. ROSE, M.D. J.D. Post.

AT 2:00 P.M. Nov 22, 1963 The suspect LEE HARVEY OSWALD was apprehended in the Texas Theatre, 231 West Jackson, Dallas by Patrolman M. N. McDONALD, Dallas Police Dept. Suspect was taken to Homicide Bureau, Dallas Police Dept. Other officers & T.O. HUDSON, Det. PAUL GENTILE, ROY NEWBY, G.T. WALKER, BOB CARROLL, EC. LYONS, GERALD HILL all Dallas Police Dept. - BOB BRANTT, F.B.I. Dallas. JAMES RANNEY, FRANK ULLA, KELLY GORSON, R.A. WALTERS all Dallas Police Dept. DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS. DISTRICT ATTORNEY JOHN T. AT 3:55 PM Nov. 22, 1963 I ISSUED SEARCH WARRANT No. SW-295 THE STATE OF TEXAS VS A.C. JOHNSON AND OTHER UNKNOWN PERSONS 1076 N. BECKLEY AVE. DALLAS, TEXAS TO J.E. BILL JONES & C.C. QUINCY Dallas SHERIFF'S DEPT. A SEARCH WAS MADE BY Lt. B.L. CUNNINGHAM, Det F.M. TURNER, WALTER R. PATTY, H.A. MOORE, B.L. SUNKER OF THE Dallas Police Dept AND ASST DA. WILLIAM F. ALEXANDER AND MYSELF. ALL PRINTERS REMOVED FROM THE ROOM OF O.H. LEE (LEE HARVEY OSWALD) WERE TAKEN TO HOMICIDE Bureau, DALLAS Police Dept. THIS SEARCH WAS MADE ABOUT 4:30 PM Nov. 22, 1963. MATERIAL RETURNED & FILED Nov. 24, 1963 AT 4:00 PM.

AT 7:05 PM Nov. 22, 1963 The Suspect LEE HARVEY OSWALD WAS CHARGED IN CASE NO. F-153 MURDER WITH MURDER OF J.D. TIPPITT. WARRANT WAS ISSUED TO CAPT. J.W. PETER Dallas Police Dept. AND THE DEFENDANT WAS ARRAIGNED AT 7:00 PM. BY READING HIM THE ACCUSATION, ADVISING HIM HE DID NOT HAVE TO MAKE ANY STATEMENT, BUT THAT ANY STATEMENT HE MADE MIGHT BE USED AGAINST HIM FOR THE CHARGES STATED AND THAT HE WOULD BE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO CONTACT HIS ATTORNEY AND DENIED BOND ON CAPITAL OFFENSE. Remanded to the Custody of the Sheriff of DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS.


AT 11:26 PM Nov. 22, 1963 The Suspect LEE HARVEY OSWALD WAS CHARGED IN CASE NO. F-154 MURDER WITH MURDER OF JOHN F. KENNEDY. WARRANT WAS ISSUED TO CAPT. J.W. PETER Dallas Police Dept. The Defendant was there about 11:00 PM Nov. 22, 1963. TAKEN TO THE DETENTION ROOM IN THE REAR PART OF THE Police Bldg. where the Press WAS ALLOWED TO INTERVIEW THE DEFENDANT FOR ABOUT 6 MINUTES. He was then REMOVED BACK INTO THE Jail By Homicide Detectives.

Between 12¹⁵ AM + 12³⁰ AM Nov. 23^d, 1963 MR. JACK RUBY WALKED UP TO ME AND GAVE ME HIS CARD AND INTRODUCED HIMSELF TO ME. I HAD SEEN HIM STANDING IN THE DETAIL ROOM W.H.O. THE PRESS INTERVIEWED THE DEFENDANT ATTACHED IS THE CARD GIVEN ME



AT 1:35 AM Nov 23^d, 1963 AT THE REQUEST OF DISTRICT ATTORNEY HENRY WADE I ARRAIGNED THE DEFENDANT LEE HARVEY OSWALD IN CAUSE NO H-154. THE ARREST WAS READ TO THE DEFENDANT AS BEFORE AND HE WAS AGAIN ADVISED OF HIS CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS. BOND WAS DENIED AS BEFORE AND THE DEFENDANT REMAINED AS BEFORE.

FROM ABOUT 1:45 AM UNTIL 3:45 AM I WAS IN CONFERENCE WITH DALLAS POLICE OFFICERS, D.A. HENRY WADE AND TWO OF HIS ASSISTANTS. I WENT HOME ABOUT 4 AM 11-23-63

AT 6:5 AM Nov. 23^d, 1963 Lt. Robert E. McKinney, Dallas Police Dept. Filed Charges OF ASSAULT TO MURDER OF JOHN B. CONNALLY IN CAUSE NO. F-155 AGAINST LEE HARVEY OSWALD. WARRANT WAS ISSUED TO Lt. McKinney AND THE DEFENDANT WAS NOT ARRAIGNED OR PRESENT WHEN THE CHARGE WAS FILED.
