The Commission would be grateful if the Federal Bureau of Investigation could assist us in preparing an exhibit for use in the Commission's report.

The Commission has received as our Document No. 1952d, blue prints of the third floor of the Dallas Police and Courts Building. From these prints we would like to have a diagram prepared which would be drawn to scale but would eliminate much of the details included in the prints. We anticipate using the diagram in the body of the report and thus wish it to be easily comprehensible.
