SUBJECT: PRESIDENT'S COMMISSION ON THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY
REQUEST FOR VISUAL AIDS

Re Director's letter to Mr. Rankin dated 7-20-64, wherein the Commission was advised that the FBI was holding in abeyance the preparation of a map of Mexico depicting the whereabouts of Lee Harvey Oswald in Mexico, pending receipt of advice as to the photographs to be utilized in connection therewith.

On 7-22-64 Mr. Norman Redlich called stating that the Commission decided against using photographs on the maps but did, however, want Oswald's whereabouts graphically indicated on a map of Mexico, Federal District. He requested that I get in touch with him to discuss this matter further at a time when I would be at the Commission building with reference to exhibits which are presently being prepared for Dr. Goldberg relating to the third floor plan of the Dallas Police Department.

This matter will be discussed with Mr. Redlich on 7-24-64.
