To properly conclude this phase of the investigation, Lewis Edward Berry, Jr., should be interviewed thoroughly, to establish his activities and the identities of his associates.

This matter should be handled immediately so that the President's Commission may be advised in view of their anticipated conclusion regarding their investigation concerning the assassination of President Kennedy.

This matter concerns inquiries concerning Lewis Edward Berry, Jr., whose wife related information concerning his activities. Mrs. Berry made numerous allegations that Berry, Jr., was mentally disturbed and also allegedly associated with a loosely knit group who are trying to organize to commit various acts of violence. Previous investigation and other individuals interviewed indicate that Berry is very strong in his convictions and had dislikes for the "Kennedys" and Berry was reported to have remarked that the assassination of President Kennedy was good for the liberals in the country, since they were getting "fed up with him."
