Enclosed is a copy of an anonymous letter bearing no date which was addressed to the Director and signed "Americans" and the envelope in which it was transmitted. Also enclosed is one copy of a letter furnished to Secret Service Headquarters concerning this matter.

Milwaukee is instructed to search indices and determine if any similar letters of this nature have been received and if the writer can be identified. Also conduct appropriate inquiries through local law enforcement agencies and other sources at Kenosha, in an attempt to identify the individual.

Results of your inquiries are to be incorporated into a letterhead memorandum suitable for dissemination to the President's Commission and to Secret Service Headquarters. Insure accuracy in this letterhead memorandum to preclude revisions or corrections by the Bureau.

This matter should be handled expeditiously in view of the anticipated early conclusion of the President's Commission concerning the assassination of President Kennedy. No inserts will be necessary for Dallas.
