We would like Agent Shancyfelt to examine this photograph in order to acaist in determining whether there is need for additional testimony concerning the photograph. The print may be picked up at the offices of the Commission.

In connection with the continuing exumination of the Zapruder film we request that Agent Shaneyfelt advise us as to the time which elapsed between freme 313 and the moment when Special Agent Hill of the Secret Service first reached the back of the Presidential limousine.
