Special Agent L. Shaneyfelt has testified concerning the retouching which was done by LIFE magazine on the photograph which appeared on the cover of the issue of February 21, 1964. The Commission has received from LIFE magazine the actual print showing the retouching which was done in preparing the cover. We would like Agent Shaneyfelt to examine this photograph in order to assist in determining whether there is need for additional testimony concerning the photograph. The print may be picked up at the offices of the Commission.

In connection with the continuing examination of the Zapruder film we request that Agent Shaneyfelt advise us as to the time which elapsed between frame 313 and the moment when Special Agent Hill of the Secret Service first reached the back of the Presidential limousine.
