Q614 One \$5.00 Federal Reserve Note, Series 1950 C, Serial Number G 58070975D bearing on reverse side the handwritten notation "will be murdered Nov 22" and the names "Jackie Kennedy" and "John F Kennedy".

Result of examination:

The handwriting on Q614 was not identified in the Anonymous Letter File. A photograph of this handwriting will be added to this file.

It was concluded that LEE HARVEY OSWALD, K4 and K5 in this case, did not prepare the handwriting on Q614.

Specimen Q614 will be retained in the Laboratory pending a determination as to when it can be properly released.
