Assassination of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy, November 22, 1963, Dallas, Texas

Bernard Weissman, 439 South Columbus Avenue,
Mount Vernon, New York, was interviewed on August 10, 1964,
at the New York Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation,
201 East 69th Street, New York, New York.

Mr. Weissman advised that he had never been in the Carousel Bay in Dallas, Texas, and also that he had never met Jack Ruby or Officer J. D. Tippit.

He stated that during November, 1963, when he was in Dallas, Texas, he was employed by Carpet Engineers, Incorporated, 1002 South Beckley Street, in the Oakcliff section of Dallas, Texas. Mr. Weissman advised that he worked from 6:00 p.m. to approximately twelve midnight and believed he was working during the evening of November 14, 1963.

Mr. Weissman also stated that during his stay in Dallas, Texas, he resided at 4618 Reiger Street with William Burley. He stated that Burley presently resides at 3353 West 33rd Avenue, Denver, Colorado.

Mr. Weissman consented to having his photograph taken, copies of which have been forwarded to The President's Commission.
