The clipping is from an unidentified Czech-language newspaper published in Chicago, Ill., of an article entitled, "A New Light On the Mystery of the Assassination of President Kennedy?"

U.S. Envoy

The article provides a brief summary of the theories on the assassination stated in a book, "Who Killed Kennedy?" by Thomas C. Buchanan published in London, i. e., that there was more than one person involved in a plot organized by Texas oilmen, who wanted to replace President Kennedy by Johnson, because they hoped, that he would change Kennedy's policy of relaxation of the international tensions and secure tax concessions for them.
