Extreme care must be taken in the preparation of this letterhead memorandum. Subsequent reporting of this matter by Dallas is not required and no insorts should be prepared by Los Angeles. Curran's letter is rambling and quite incoherent in places and while there is reluctance to initiate such investigation on an apparent mental case, it is nevertheless felt we have the responsibility to check this matter out in view of the allegations and the fact Curran indicates he has also advised the Attorney General of this information.

We have not received a referral from the Department. When the LHM is received, it will be disseminated to the President's Commission. and Department.
