Office of Senator Everett M. Dirksen (Republican-Illinois) was advised by Mr. DeLoach's Office based on telephone call from Baltimore Office 9-1-64, of threat to assassinate Senator. Capitol Police and other local police also alerted. The President's Commission is being advised. Since there is no indication that telephone call referred to in incoming was interstate, there would be no violation of the Federal Extortion Statute and no investigation is being pursued.
