First anonymous letter postmarked 7-9-64, Kenosha, Wisconsin, second anonymous letter postmarked 7-30-64, Kenosha, Wisconsin, furnished by the office of Governor Connally of Texas. Both letters allege President Johnson was involved in some manner in the assassination of President Kennedy and made other allegations generally in opposition to President Johnson. Copies of these communications have been furnished to Secret Service. The FBI Laboratory has established that both letters written by the same individual. Logical efforts made to identify the writer have been negative. No further action is warranted.
