Re: Airtel and letterhead memorandum dated 8-29-64.

Before re letterhead memorandum can be disseminated it is necessary that revised Page 1 be promptly submitted to the Bureau and Dallas with the following corrections:

1. Delete property stamp.

2. Delete last sentence, Paragraph 1. It is pointed out when calling attention to errors in a communication by underlining, it is essential that all such errors be underlined otherwise those errors not underlined will appear to have been made by the FBI. For example, in the second paragraph of the anonymous letter, last line, first word, "nominated" is capitalized which is incorrect. Further, in Paragraph 4, Line 4, Word 4, is misspelled, but neither of these errors are underlined. It is acceptable to merely state that a quoted communication is a true copy and then just appropriately quote each paragraph as is done. In this particular case the Bureau is erasing all underlining appearing in the quoted communication. You should do likewise.

In addition the Bureau is making the following corrections to your letterhead memorandum:

Page 3, Paragraph 3, Line 6, end of line should be a semicolon.

Page 4, Line 1, Word 7, should be "are." Line 3, a semicolon should be placed after Word 7. Paragraph 1, Line 4, place a semicolon after Word 8.

For your information re letterhead memorandum consists of an original typewritten copy and seven Xerox copies. You should insure that your revision is similarly prepared.

You are reminded to take extreme care in the preparation of communications intended for dissemination. This matter must be handled so that dissemination can be effected at the earliest possible time.

NOTE: Milwaukee has received two anonymous communications which have been identified by our Laboratory as having been written by the same individuals. Both communications are substantially the same and allege that President Johnson was involved in the assassination, and other irrelevant ramblings. We have made dissemination in the past to Secret Service and the Commission. When this matter is complete, similar dissemination will be made.
