Oliver of the University of Illinois before an audience in the auditorium of the Santa Ana Valley High School, Santa Ana, California. and pinned him down on the basis for some of his remarks. One of his remarks was to the effect that Secretary of Defense McNamara ordered the Department of the Army to rehearse for the President's funeral one week before the funeral took place. Oliver claimed he obtained this data from a newspaper article in the "Clarion Ledger." We reviewed such article and noted that there was nothing to substantiate Oliver's statement. Instead, an Army officer indicated the Army was in a state of readiness for the funeral because it had finished funeral rehearsal because there was grave concern for President Hoover's health at that time. Obviously Oliver has given the article a vicious and extremely false twist. Commission is preparing to question Oliver under oath and the enclosed newspaper clipping will be of value to the Commission in such testimony.
