INCTES:

This is the 26th letter to the Commission on livitin, who is the subject of UAC Letter 64-23 (D) dited 4-28-64, based on her continuing prolific letter of the Director and the PBI. writing caupaign to vilify the Director and the PDI. Linetin has been described as a "bright nut" and since the assassination has been conducting her own investigation. The Commission received a telegram from Martin indicating she possessed pertinent information relating to the assassination rifle and the shets fired at the President. While expressing reluctance, Villens stated he felt Martin must be interviewed. Agents of our Oklahoma City Office interviewed her on 9-17-64, for approximately 10 winutes at which time she refused to furnish any information indicating she did not have to speak with FDI Agents if not "emotionally oriented." She also denied the wording in the telegram and stated she would continue to wait for a proper reply from the Commission and if they wanted the information in her possession, they could subpoen her. Kartin was not abusive to cur Agents at this time; however, her actions were very erratic and suggested emotional instability.
