ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, DALLAS, TEXAS, 11/22/63  
MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION CONCERNING

WFO received long-distance telephone call 9:01 a.m., 9/21/64, from woman who refused to identify herself but who stated she was calling from Cincinnati, Ohio. Caller stated that shortly after death of President KENNEDY, local newspapers in her area carried story to effect that K. C. CASON, aka "JACK" GASON, owner of building containing Texas Book Depository, from where President shot, was originally from Cynthiana, Kentucky. Caller advised the "Cynthiana Democrat" carried such a story. Caller related local newspapers now state that mother of K. C. CASON, identified as MARY ELIZABETH CASON BURGESS of Cynthiana, has recently died at age of eighty and was scheduled to be buried at the Smith-Rees Funeral Home, Cynthiana. Caller stated she thought MARY ELIZABETH CASON BURGESS might have been of interest to authorities investigating assassination inasmuch as caller thought BURGESS was either in Dallas or in transit there at time of assassination.

Caller thought above information might be of interest to Warren Commission and stated she was calling
