By letter dated September 2, 1964, Mr. Herbert J. Miller, Jr., Assistant Attorney General, Criminal Division, U. S. Department of Justice, Washington, D.C., furnished to the Director, FBI, a letter written by Leo A. Gorman of 3712 East Anaheim Street, Long Beach, California. This letter by Gorman was addressed to former Attorney General Robert F. Kennedy and contained two copies of Gorman's writings captioned, "Views on the History, Politics, and Philosophy of America" and "An Analysis of the Character of the Assassin of President John F.
