Dear Bob;

Problems! Do they ever end? Here's another one.

Right now I'm in the middle of an affair in which possibly 200 different agents of the FBI have saundered across my path at one time or another. I play volley ball at the beach with them; sit with them at baseball games and have coffee with them every morning and all the time we never refer specifically to who they are.

This, basically, is a "help no" letter but by the end of it I hope you'll be able to find enough to justify your interest.

The allegations aginst no (either initiated or the fires of the charges came from the Burcau itself or some people at my last employer - North American Aviation in Downey):

- (1) Reasonable or near chance of boing a potential assassin of a president of the United States like the suspect Oswald
 - (2) Fotontial or actual child nolestor
 - (3) Active homosexual
 - (4) Alcholic
 - (5) A communist
 - (6) A slew of others.

The reason for writing this letter is that it appears that the FSI is satisfied that every siginficant charge was false and consciously false to the knowledge or the people who initiated or supported the charges but due to nisgivings over some of the tactic they employed when they first considered that I might be an possible assassin and two again to the deep love and admiration we all had for your brother the President, John Ennedy there seem to be great difficulty to wind it up.

The following are instances that occurred or are occurring and which they are having difficulty in resolving in their mines as to they did some of them and how, if at all, they could be rectified:

(1) Ly firstacless mail has been opened and the contents divulged to a new rather large public. This letter you are new reading I assume was opened and knowledge of it phoned to you or one of your assistants

I fool they wish they had never started reading my mail and are at a noral loss to emplain, now, just why they did start.

(2) I'm a mild - mannered, rather withdrawa person, who is extremely reticent on what they consider key matters (I see it as preserving my integrity);

For the above reason the following has occurred:

(a) Blowing auto horns at me about once every 12 hours for the last 31 months

(b) Threats by agents of the FBI - these threats were from their frustration - since we've built up a strong respect and admiration for each other

The two enclosed writings of mine are ones that I sincerely believe. When I pass them out to people, I say they were written for the purpose of self - expression but this is a thin well for the truth that they were written to give the FDI some thing tangible.

has had a hard life. By father, who passed away in 1958, expressed his frustrations in life through physical violence upon her person and face about once a week from 1930 to 1950.

It's never a mother's proudest day when a clean cut FBI agent calls on her and inquires of her information to resolve an allegation that her son may be a possible assassin along with the other charges.

For the road my mother has had to travel in life, I doubt if it was a very pleasant day.

For the love of the Sacred Heart, in your charity I would ask that you look into this and if you come to essentially the same conclusion as had been expressed in this letter possibly on another day in the future you could see that another clean cut FBI agent walks down the same street to her home and might say:

At the time we last called on you:

- (1) We were not cortain of the type of person Oswald was
- (2) We were not certain of the type of person your son was
- (3) We were not certain of the type of persons his accusors were. & so forth.

This present position is that the Bareau office here some at a loss at what to do nowt:

- (1) I've lost about \$2000 in wages
- (2) Ly name as a possible suspect has been given very extensive coverage making i.t difficult, as a point of reality, for us to get a job.

The issue would seem to be leadership.

is all those charges and estivities go on around integrity and have tritten about 400 pages of letters over the last 32 months to my parish priests - Fathers Hollinger and Killian C.P. on thic FOI & MAA influence

At present, I don't work (I havn't for the last 4 months).

I croad my time sitting across from clear - cut FDI agents at libraries or coffee chops writing papers line the enclosed two; cracking jokes with them or just discussing the newspaper headline stories of the day.

The two enclosed letters from Vesley Grapp are "cover" letters from him thanking me for mailing each of the statements es I turned them out. .

We know each other and the true meaning of the letters.

I took the first statement over on 23 June to his office and he and I teck stock of each other without saying just that.

One phone call to hir. Grapp would fill you in on this. There must be other concerns in the Los Angeles office of the FEI right not but I can't bolieve it. They must have about 30 agents, not the follows who work for the agents, around central Long Beach

This intensive activity has been going on for 4 months in a gradual ascent.

One problem right now is that there has been wide spread distribution of my picture and knowledge of my person as being identified with these charges and the question emists as how to blank out these past impressions so that I can get a job (I was en ongineer doing enelysic work at \$6000 per year) and return to anonymity.

This letter, I realize, sounds very detached and seemingly indifferent. I'd studied to be a Consdictine Priest in the past and can homestly say that I'm very religious so that with a Surrender of my will to The Sacred Heart I don't worry too much

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ly personal view is that for throughout the history of America,

Every agent of the Bureau who has given his life in themperformance of his duties;

Every man in the services who laid down his life in battle;

Every policemen who has ever died in the line of duty;

May I respectfully and honestly ask you to look into this matter, and if that is your decision, provide the leaderchip so that those banners may continue to wave over our land in the sight of our Lord and Savier, Jesus Christ.

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VIEWS ON THE HISTORY, POLITICS AND PHILOSOPHY



A story of the Greeks and the analogy it provides for us.

Of the Peloponnesian War, Thucydides relates that the Athenian Greeks ceased to be a great and feared power in the Mediterranean when they fought and were defeated at equal numbers by the Greeks at Syracuse in Sicily. The reason they were defeated for the first time at equal numbers when hitherto they were usually victorious against heavy odds is that they fought a people for the first time who believed in the same principles they did. Their defeat demonstrated that their power was not unique or mysterious to themselves but rather lay in the fact that they were human beings who adhered to certain ideas and it was the resultant strength that men could bring to life by holding these principles that made them great.

The moral Thucydides drew from this was that other countries lost their fear of the "Athenian Greek Magic" by seeing them defeated. The anology relative to America, in my opinion, is that Americans are human beings no better or worse as such than any other group of people on the planet but what lies at the greatness of America, and great I believe it to be, are the principles that we espouse and specifically that the people of this land believing in these concepts.

The analogy of the Greeks to our situation is that with the prolonged ideological conflict with Russia, there exists the lendency, even if not articulated, on the part of Americans to tone down the striking features of our principles, emphasize those characteristics which are less offensive to communists under the opinion that this would reduce tensions if the source of those tensions were not highlighted. While recognizing this to be the case, I advocate that we perceive that the following principles (the ones enumerated are ones) that I am deeply committed to and when in the course of duty to country a man may die it is specifically in delense of these that I would undertake that duty):

- (a) Sanctity of the individual
- (b) Right to privacy
- (c) The doctrine that men are not the creatures of the state but rather that the state exists only to serve its citizen.
- (d) That it derives its authority from God

(e) That its citizens have the freedom to pullicly worship God

make us great and that in time of danger, when we are challenged for holding them, that we should increase our devotion to them.

My personal philosophy of life is that I am an individual created by Our Lord; that I after American citizen who loves his country, is prepared to die in its defense, and believes in the right of that country to self-defense against enemies that would attack it.

As one human being, what can I do to promote its welfare -- while I do not pretend to perfectly comprehend, less perfectly act on these truths: I believe, in a generation which is rare for the procession of these qualities, in possessing a love and adoration of Our Lord for His cwr. sake as a primary reason for living and motive for acting and on a more mundanc level, of possessing a personal honor which will not sacrifice its principles for the acquisition of money or power. To be more truthful, for the above reasons, not to pursue these goals at all.

What explains a person who reads a great deal, does not extensively socialize, marry, have children, try to accept responsibility or strive for a better material well-being? I have read above 3,000 books. I enjoy being alone from the standpoint of thinking about what I read and spiritual meditation. I enjoy living in a country that respects my personal freedom and has faith in individual human beings —faith that their efforts to be true to themselves and strengthen their integrity will in the long run benefit both the individual and society.

To achieve the above goals it does not inhere that a person has to remain single, be less social than average or place position or money low on a system of values, but I find this attitude to afford less room for compromise.

What do such attitudes meen in social terms? Can we have a viable society if each person does not contribute to his capacity for the Gross National Product? Yes, if we appreciate the fact that other courses are open and accept the fact that some people will take them. Why doesn't a person who feels this way go into a conventional role such as a teacher? Again, I feel it is exercising the capacity God gave and the freedoms our political system conferred to be an individual. If Lincoln had lived and died in Springfield, Illinois, never gaining any fame but still possessing his strong faith in God and integrity, I feel his life would still have meaning because his will acted on the graces. Our Lord bestowed on him to develop his strong character.

The genius of America in history, and I am tainking here in political and natural terms, is that it professed the faith that any person could be capable of greatness if given the opportunity. Systems prior to this entrusted its opportunities and destiny on its Aristocracy and it exceptional persons rose from the common populace, it assimilated him into the favored class. Coming from the point of theoretically expressing faith in the average person with the Declaration of Independence and Bill of Rights in 1776, Abraham Lincoln afforded history an example of the truth of this belief.

Another seature of which I am proud to be an American would be the sollowing example. In the Central Valley of California we do not have orientals blowing up gas stations as a occurring in Venezuela. The reason is that for someone who is poor opportunity to improve his status by personal initiative exists as a safety valve to present in the cough that it is the policy of our government to disseminate it to other lands as a means to deal with the social and political problems that have arisen in the 20th century.

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RE: LEO A. GORMAN

The following investigation was conducted at Long Beach, California, on September 15, 1964:

The files of the Long Beach Police Department (LBPD) were caused to be checked and no record identifiable with Leo A. Gorman was located.

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Detective Sergeant Ray Henry, Anti-Subversive Detail, LBPD, advised his files contained no information identifiable with Gorman.

Long Beach Credit Association files contained a credit report dated June 29, 1962, for Leo A. Gorman, age 29, listed as single as of 1962, residence 3712 East Anaheim Street, Long Beach, California (seven months as of June 29, 1962).

This report indicated former residences as 3942 8th Street, San Diego, California (one year) and 14 Clifford Place, Brooklyn, New York. His occupation was listed as designer and mechanical engineer, North American Aviation, Downey, California; former employment - General Dynamics, New York City. His military service was in the U. S. Army, 1958-1961.

The last inquiry, according to the file, was dated September 13, 1962, at which time residence address was changed to 4944 Hayter, Long Beach, California.

On September 16, 1964, an effort was made to locate and interview Gorman at 3712 East Anaheim Street, Long Beach, California. Mr. Gorman was not in his room during the entire day.

managing of the Park Hotel, 3712 East Anaheim Street, Long Beach, for her friend, Mrs. Rustermeyer, was contacted. She said she had been there about two weeks and during that time had become acquainted with Leo Gorman. She said he did not have any employment and spent most of his time reading various religious books and writing letters. She volunteered that she considered him in need of medical attention for mental reasons. She said she had been a nurse for many years at the California State Hospital for the Mentally Ill at Norwalk, California, is a registered nurse, and in her opinion, Mr. Gorman is mentally unbalanced.

On September 16, 1964,

Manager, Park Hotel, 3712 Fast Anaheim Street, Long Beach,
California, advised that she had known Leo Gorman for about
14 or 15 months. She said Gorman was supposedly previously
employed at the North American Aviation Company, Downey,
California. She volunteered that she considered him "dingy,"
and she explained further that he seemed to be in another world.

On September 17, 1964,

Investigations Office, North American Aviation, Downey,
California, advised that Leo A. Gorman of 3712 East Anaheim
Street, Long Beach, California, had been employed at that
plant from May, 1962, until April 9, 1964. He was persuaded
to resign at that time as his supervisors had repeatedly
stated, in the last few months before his resignation, that he
had become incapable mentally of concentrating on his work and
continuously made weird complaints of being followed and
investigated.

such, but did interview Gorman prior to his termination. During this interview, Gorman gave several instances of when he believed he was followed by "Federal Agents." He said that he believed every theater box office in the Los Angeles area had his photograph and had instructions to have him sit in a certain location in the theater.

stated that Gorman advised at the conclusion of his interview that about three weeks prior, he had visited a doctor. This doctor had examined him and said there was nothing physically wrong with him, but that he worried too much. The doctor had given him some mild tranquilizers and told him to return in a month or so.

In view of the opinion of a registered nurse, that Mr. Gorman is mentally unbalanced, and in view of the nature of his letters to the Los Angeles FBI Office, which appear to be irrational, he was not interviewed.
