

SUMMARY FROM SPANISH

An airmail envelope, postmarked October 15, 1964, and a four-page, handwritten letter, to Mr. Nicholas Katzenbach, from:

Mr. Jesus Velasquez Munoz,  
Labarra - Rio Cana,  
Caguas, Puerto Rico

The writer says that he has made a "complete analysis" of the Kennedy assassination. He states that it all began in Birmingham, Alabama when Governor George Wallace "called out the National Guard..." The writer feels that there was a plot set up by Governor George Wallace, Jack Ruby and Leo Oswald. The writer says that Ruby killed Oswald to prevent him from talking.

Upon closing the writer states, "I am going to tell you something very confidential. Governor George Wallace became the No. 1 enemy of President Johnson, and of everyone who is in favor of Civil Rights." (sic)

(Translator's Note: In a previous letter, the writer gave similar "information" and claimed that he had received it by mental telepathy. In this letter the writer does not mention mental telepathy, but says he has arrived at this conclusion as a result of studying "press articles, magazines, peoples' opinion, photographs,...")
