ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY, NOVEMBER TWENTYTWO, NINETEEN SIXTYTHREE, DALLAS, TEXAS, MISCELLANEOUS DASH INFORMATION CONCERNING.

RE BUREAU TELETYPE TO DALLAS AND SAN ANTONIO SEPTEMBER THIRTY LAST AND SAN ANTONIO TELETYPE TO BUREAU AND DALLAS OCTOBER FIVE LAST CONCERNING TEXAS ATTORNEY GENERAL WAGGONER CARR'S REPORT.

REVIEW OF TEXAS AG'S REPORT ON ASSASSINATION BY DALLAS FAILS TO REFLECT ANY CRITICISMS OF FBI OR DISCREPANCIES NOT POINTED OUT BY SAN ANTONIO IN REFERENCED SAN ANTONIO TELETYPE.

IT IS NOTED THAT THE SPELLING OF THE NAME J.D. TIPPIT IS ERRONEOUS ON PAGES ONE AND TEN.

CONSIDERABLE PUBLICITY GIVEN TO TEXAS REPORT IN BOTH DALLAS NEWSPAPERS ON OCTOBER FIVE AND SIX LAST, COPIES OF WHICH PUBLICITY BEING FURNISHED BUREAU BY AIRTEL TODAY.

QUOTE THE DALLAS TIMES HERALD UNQUOTE OF OCTOBER SIX LAST STATES TEXAS AG'S REPORT CONTAINED CORRESPONDENCE BETWEEN CHIEF OF POLICE JESSE E. CURRY AND J. LEE RANKIN ABOUT THE CONTROVERSIAL MEMORANDUM BY LT. JACK REVILL. IT SHOULD BE NOTED ACTUAL REPORT CONSISTS OF ONLY TWENTY PAGES AND DOES NOT GO INTO SPECIFICS, BUT OTHER PUBLICITY TENDS TO INDICATE THAT THERE ARE NUMEROUS EXHIBITS AND DOCUMENTS IN THE POSSESSION OF THE TEXAS AG WHICH SUPPORT THE ACTUAL REPORT AND APPARENTLY NEWS PUBLICITY REFERS TO THE EXHIBITS AND DOCUMENTS RATHER THAN THE ACTUAL CONTENTS OF THE REPORT.

THE ABOVE REFERRED TO NEWSPAPER PUBLICITY CONCERNING THE CONTROVERSIAL MEMORANDUM OF LT. JACK REVILL INDICATES THAT CHIEF OF POLICE JESSE E. CURRY IN A LETTER DATED MAY TWENTYEIGHT LAST TO J. LEE RANKIN STATED THAT THE FBI HAD ASKED HIM TO RETRACT A STATEMENT HE HAD MADE TO THE PRESS ON NOVEMBER TWENTYTWO, SIXTYTHREE, TO THE EFFECT THAT HE HAD RECEIVED INFORMATION THAT

THE FBI KNEW OF OSWALD'S PRESENCE IN DALLAS.

THIS ARTICLE STATES THAT WITHIN A FEW MINUTES OF HIS STATEMENT TO THE PRESS, HE RECEIVED A TELEPHONE CALL FROM ME IN WHICH I STATED THAT THE BUREAU WAS EXTREMELY DESIROUS THAT CURRY RETRACT HIS STATEMENT.

DALLAS FILE REFLECTS MEMORANDUM BY ME DATED NOVEMBER TWENTYTWO SIXTYTHREE TO THE EFFECT THAT ON NIGHT OF NOVEMBER TWENTYTWO, SIXTYTHREE I TELEPHONICALLY CONTACTED CHIEF CURRY AND POINTED OUT TO HIM THAT THE FBI HAD NOT INTERVIEWED OSWALD IN DALLAS AND THAT WE WERE UNDER NO OBLIGATION, AS HE WAS APPARENTLY INDICATING, TO FURNISH HIM INFORMATION ON ALL SECURITY SUBJECTS IN THE AREA; THAT WE HAD NO INDICATION OSWALD WAS LIKELY TO KILL THE PRESIDENT AND THAT WE WERE EXTENDING TO HIM FULL COOPERATION. ON THIS OCCASION, CHIEF CURRY ADVISED HE HE WAS REPEATING INFORMATION SOMEONE HAD TOLD HIM AND HE COULD NOT REMEMBER WHO HAD TOLD HIM, AND THE NEXT TIME HE WAS ON TV HE WOULD RECTIFY THIS ERROR. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT

CHIEF CURRY DID GO BACK ON TV AND SAID HE WAS ONLY REPEATING INFORMATION THAT SOMEONE HAD TOLD HIM AND HE COULD NOT REMEMBER WHO. HE STATED THE FBI HAD NO OBLIGATION TO FURNISH HIM SUCH INFORMATION AND THAT FBI WAS COOPERATING WITH HIM ONE HUNDRED PER CENT.
