MICHAEL OPALINSKI

The above captioned individual who resides at [redacted] Ohio, advised SA JAMES E. GILLEY on October 9, 1964, that [redacted] who is employed at the [redacted] Company in [redacted] Ohio, is planning to kill him (OPALINSKI). He stated he had written the President of the United States, Mr. HOOVER of the FBI, and the United States Supreme Court concerning [redacted]

During the interview with OPALINSKI, [redacted] he mentioned that [redacted] had killed President KENNEDY but would not supply any facts or additional information other than the fact that [redacted] had a rifle at his home.

SA GILLEY asked OPALINSKI if he had contacted the FBI before and he denied any previous contacts or interviews.

The files of the Cleveland Division reflect that MICHAEL OPALINSKI was interviewed on September 10, 1957 and September 29, 1959, when he complained that [redacted] was making life miserable for him and he suspected that this individual was a member of the Russian Secret Police.

OPALINSKI also contacted a radio station in Canton, Ohio, in 1957 indicating that [redacted] was spreading communist propaganda.
