NOTE: Rawles, a British seaman, wrote to the American Embassy in London on 6/7/64 and 6/26/64 alleging he had met a wealthy American named [redacted] who stated sometime prior to the assassination that Kennedy would be assassinated. Efforts to identify [redacted] have been negative, however Rawles stated he had information at his residence which would appear could identify [redacted] Legat, London, through its sources has been experiencing considerable difficulty in locating Rawles for additional interview and submitted referenced airtel seeking Bureau advice as to whether efforts should be continued to locate him. While it is probable Rawles has little if any positive information of value, it is felt the best way to resolve this matter is to confront Rawles and obtain the documentary information which should identify [redacted] and check this matter out once and for all. Therefore it is recommended we continue to check this matter out.
