Enclosed for the Bureau are the original and four copies of a letterhead memo (LHM), dated and captioned as above concerning letter received from anonymous source by Dr. NEWMAN T. REED, New Mexico State University (NMSU). N.M.

On the same date, a letter was received by Dr. MARION P. HARDMAN, female English professor at NMSU, containing two white 3 x 5 cards on one of which was printed in red paint or water coloring the words, "GET OUT OF HERE YOU BITCH!" The matter of Dr. MARION P. HARDMAN's receipt of this letter is being handled separately and the USA is being contacted to determine if this letter constitutes a violation of the Extortion Statute.

On 10/22/64, there were found in the English Building at the University two other 3 x 5 cards, one bearing the words "LETS OUST COMMIES LIKE HARDMAN & WANZER" printed in same manner as above card and second card similarly printed bearing words, "3 OF THESE YOUNG HALLERS ARE GUS HALLERS - NEWMAN T. REED MARION P. HARDMAN ORV WENZER" N.M.

In view of the reference to "NOVEMBER 22 IN DALLAS TEXAS," this matter is being submitted to the Bureau for information although there appears to be no threat involved and no actual information pertinent to the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY.
