Result of examination:

The typewriting on D-271 was not identified in the
Anonymous Letter File. Appropriate photographs will be added
to this file.

The typewriting on D-271 matches most closely a
Laboratory standard for a Smith-Corona pica style of type
measuring ten letters per inch.

No watermarks, indented writings or other significant
features were noted in D-271 which would indicate the source of the
envelope and paper.

The submitted evidence is retained.
