There are enclosed 25 copies of an insert reflecting information regarding [redacted] and an interview with [redacted]. The sources of the information are identified in the insert. The information from the American Consulate General in Stuttgart was received on 9-8-64 and the information from the 66th Intelligence Corps Group, U. S. Army, Europe, was received through the Office of Deputy Chief of Staff, Intelligence, U. S. Army, Europe, on 10-19-64. The Group's information was recorded in an Agent Report dated 9-11-64, prepared by J. C. MARLO III, Special Agent of the Group. Attached to that report was a Xerox copy of the Germanlanguage statement signed by [redacted] which is translated in the insert. That copy is also enclosed for the Bureau's records.

The information received from the Consulate General included copies of some documents originating with both the Department of State and the U. S. Immigration and Naturalization Service, which documents pertain to GRAF's deportation and were furnished to the Consulate by the Department of State. Since these documents were evidently not complete information on the deportation, they were not included in the insert. It is felt that information on this deportation would be more properly obtained from the Immigration and Naturalization Service records.
