I want you, Mr. Hoover, to assure me that the information I gave you is not only correct but that assurance of its correctness will be given to Mrs. Marguerite Oswald and all members of the Oswald family in order that their human rights are not further strangled.

The very foundations of liberty depend upon your decision.
