NOTE:

[REDACTED] an informant of unknown reliability alleged an
integrated, interstate gang hired Oswald and two others to
assassinate President Kennedy because the President was in favor of
legislation to recall all currency and reissue it in a different
color which would affect gang's funds. It is significant that the
reported main perpetrator was shot and died on 10/26/64. Further, we
have never developed information indicating anyone other than Oswald
involved in assassination. [REDACTED] has consented to take a polygraph
examination and same will be afforded to determine the authenticity of the
information furnished by him. In view of allegations U. S. Secret
Service will be advised.
