Enclosed for New York and Dallas is one copy each of a self-explanatory letter from the President's Commission dated 11-18-64 concerning one Louis Kleppel.

No information identifiable with Kleppel could be located in Bureau files.

New York should check indices on Kleppel and furnish any pertinent results to the Bureau and Dallas so that a determination can be made as to whether further investigation in this matter is warranted.

NOTE:

Commission letter indicates that Kleppel contacted a member of the Commission staff on 11-6-64 and stated he had information of "vital importance" concerning the assassination. Kleppel alleged he had previously been in touch with the Chief Justice and the FBI. Kleppel admitted being a mental case and stated the Government "had nothing to lose" by interviewing him. The Commission furnished this for whatever action we deem appropriate. It is not felt this nebulous type of information is worthy of other than a cursory indices check. If any information of pertinence is developed from a review of New York files, consideration will be given to instituting appropriate investigation.
