On 11/19/64, Mrs. Adele Lippard, Secretary to Attorney Howard P. Willens, Criminal Division of the Department and former staff member of the President's Commission, called J. R. Halley and inquired about the ownership of the Texas School Book Depository Building (TSBDB) from where Oswald fired the shots that killed Fresident Kennedy.

Halley ascertained this information was desired by Attorney Joseph J. Cella of the Department and Halley learned from Cella that this information was desired in order to answer a legal question from the President's Commission concerning the possibility of retaining certain exhibits picked up at the TSEDB.

Malley advised Cella on 11/20/64, that according to a Secret Service Report of SAs Arthur W. Blake, William N. Carter and Elmer W. Moore dated 12/7/63, at Dallas, Texas, (62-109060-2074 Exhibit #61), the TSBDB is leased from Fr. D. Harold Eyrd, 6909 Vassar, Dallas, who has owned the building for many years building for many years.
