MISC. - INFORMATION CONCERNING

On 11/19/64, Mrs. Adele Lippard, Secretary to Attorney Howard P. Willens, Criminal Division of the Department and former staff member of the President's Commission, called J. R. Malley and inquired about the ownership of the Texas School Book Depository Building (TSBDB) from where Oswald fired the shots that killed President Kennedy.

Malley ascertained this information was desired by Attorney Joseph J. Cella of the Department and Malley learned from Cella that this information was desired in order to answer a legal question from the President's Commission concerning the possibility of retaining certain exhibits picked up at the TSBDB.

Malley advised Cella on 11/20/64, that according to a Secret Service Report of SAs Arthur W. Blake, William N. Carter and Elmer W. Moore dated 12/7/63, at Dallas, Texas, (62-109060-2074 Exhibit #61), the TSBDB is leased from Mr. D. Harold Lyrd, 6909 Vassar, Dallas, who has owned the building for many years.
