What is the DALLAS INTERNATIONAL Cultural and Social Circle?

The Dallas International Cultural and Social Circle is a non-profit, non-sectarian, non-political association of native born and foreign born citizens of Dallas, established for the purpose of better understanding between them.

What are the Aims of the Dallas International Cultural and Social Circle?

Assisting the members of the community of Dallas in fostering understanding between native and foreign born Americans as individuals and groups.

Assisting newcomers from other countries in their spiritual, educational and cultural needs; and bringing them into the stream of American life.

3. Assisting anyone who is interested in foreign languages, and encouraging children and young people to learn a foreign language.

4. Establishing a language laboratory.

How Can These Aims Be Accomplished?

The tools for the accomplishment of these aims are the following programs of the Dallas International Cultural and Social Circle:

A. The LANGUAGE PROGRAM has been established for the purpose of:

1. Helping newcomers to overcome the language barrier in our English language circle.

2. Encouraging children and young people to learn a foreign language, and bringing to attention of parents the tremendous need for foreign languages in the coming decades.

3. Giving the opportunity to everyone with an advanced knowledge of a language to use it in monthly conversations with people of the same language level.

4. Encouraging members of the community to take advantage of the knowledge of languages that many of our newcomers have to offer in our foreign language circles.

5. Bringing the tremendous help of a language laboratory to the attention of people interested in language.

E. The CULTURAL PROGRAM has been established for the purpose of:

1. Becoming aware of the duties and responsibilities to the community as Americans, through the study of American culture in its many forms.

2. Understanding other people's behavior through learning about their particular background and culture.

2. Interchanging ideas of culture in discussion groups.

C. The SOCIAL PROGRAM has been established for the purpose of:

1. Assisting the intergroup relations of foreign and native born Americans.

2. Raising funds for a language laboratory for language facilities and for cultural projects.

3. Annually honoring outstanding language students.

D. The FUTURE PROGRAM includes:

1. Plans towards the establishment of our own meeting place.

2. Plans for traveling in groups, by charter plane, etc.

3. Plans for scholarships to outstanding language students.
