No information identifiable with Riley could be located in Dureau files. In vies of allogation that Riley witnessed assassination and saw an individual standing in the window with a rifle, he should be inrediately located and interviewed and the results submitted to Dallas by Jackson with appropriate inserts. Jackson should insure that Siley is aware of the possible penalty for furnishing false information to a Federal officer and it should also be ascertained as to why he has not furnished this information befora.

Inastuch as Riley is employed by a subcontractor at the High Test Sile in Rancock County, Mississioni, Ner Orleans is relating to incorporate that information relating to his arrest 1 "on 11/15/64, by the St. Teuxany Parish Sheriff's Office for "grunk and disturbing the peace" in an appropriate letterhead reporandum and furnich same to the Eurcau and Jackson so that dipsemination can be made to MASA locally and at Fashington, D. C.

This matter should be promptly handled and a copy of the rebults of Jackson's intervier with Riley should be furnished for the information of the Bureau.

In view of his employment at a Government facility dissemination regarding his arrest should also be made.
