Beach, New Jersey.

ENNO STANN aka states correct name is ENO
DIRK OSCAR JOSEPH ANTHONY BERGHEGE...

For the information of the Bureau, in 1953,
the Newark Office was in receipt of information from
a resident of Spring Lake Heights, New Jersey, indicating
that ENO BERGHEGE and his wife recently from Holland
had made statements criticizing the United States. He
stated BERGHEGE was employed as a musician. This informa-
tion was made available to INS, Newark, New Jersey.

For the information of the Bureau, ENNO STANN aka
is described by a Bradley Beach, New Jersey, source as
being a "whirly bird".

STANN admits having visited many psychiatrists
and his entire interview, results of which are enclosed
for Dallas, was in a rambling, non-sensical fashion. He
could be considered the "chronic-type complainer".
