Enclosed for the Bureau is a thirty-page memorandum entitled "~~A Small Matter of Arithmetic~~," which was furnished the Los Angeles Office by GEORGE C. THOMSON, a civil engineer, 1528 Canada Blvd., Suite 208, Glendale, California, on 11/23/64.

The memorandum questions certain conclusions reached by the Warren Commission and attempts to show the lack of logic on the part of the Commission in reaching these conclusions. Page number one of the memorandum questions the credibility of certain testimony furnished by SA ROBERT A. FRAZIER of the FBI Laboratory.

The memorandum is being furnished the Bureau in accordance with THOMSON's request that it be brought to the attention of the Director, and in view of his indicated intent to discuss the matter with the Director. There appears to be reason to question THOMSON's mental health in view of his general demeanor in captioned matter.
