On 11/30/64, [redacted], personally appeared at the Missoula, Montana, RA. [redacted] related that in 1938, while in the Oklahoma National Guard, specific Unit not recalled, date or month not recalled, the Army and Navy were holding joint maneuvers in the San Antonio, Texas, area.

A troupe train containing members of the Oklahoma National Guard of which he was a member, and another train containing Naval personnel, both stopped in Dallas, Texas, for about four hours, from about 8:00 p.m. to midnight. He and associates, identities not recalled, went to a night club, located three or four blocks from the troupe train.

While drinking in this night club, they met several Naval Officers, all Harvard University graduates including Lt. JOHN F. KENNEDY.

[redacted] stated he had two dances with a waitress in the night club, following which Lt. KENNEDY asked to be introduced to said waitress. [redacted] related that Lt. KENNEDY stated "you just kid her for a hop and tell her my name is OSWALD." [redacted] stated he complied and when he introduced Lt. KENNEDY to the waitress as Mr. OSWALD, she stated, "That's strange, my [redacted] is OSWALD also."

[redacted] stated that Lt. KENNEDY danced once with this waitress and then she told both [redacted] and KENNEDY that she did not like to dance and that she was pregnant. [redacted] stated that he has since learned that LEE HARVEY OSWALD was born in 1939, and the waitress may have been LEE HARVEY OSWALD's mother. She told [redacted] that her husband was unemployed.

[redacted] described the waitress, whose name was allegedly OSWALD, as follows:

[redacted] appeared to be mentally disturbed when relating this information. He stated that he had been confined for psychiatric treatment in the Westchester, Pennsylvania, Hospital in 1947, and was also confined for a year in the Oklahoma State Mental Hospital at Venita, Oklahoma, in 1949. The latter confinement was at the request of his ex-wife, while he was residing in Pawnee, Oklahoma, according to [redacted]
