SUBJECT: KENNEDY ASSASSINATION FILE

DATE: 12/2/64

Reference is made to my memorandum dated 11/30/64, advising that CIA was interested in obtaining a copy of the assassination film from the Bureau on a loan basis. CIA intends to use the film for training purposes and had obtained the approval for the release of the film from Mr. Goldberg of the Warren Commission. The Liaison Agent was instructed to confirm the loan of this film by letters to the Commission and to CIA.
