HAROLD DEE RILEY

On November 18, 1964, Sergeant Webster Clemments, Deputy Sheriff, St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office, Covington, Louisiana, stationed at Slidell, Louisiana, advised that on November 15, 1964, he and Deputy Sheriff Richard Hussey had arrested one Harold Dee Riley on a charge of drunk and disturbing the peace. He stated Riley is a white male, age 34, 5'6", 152 pounds, blue eyes, brown hair, and has a permanent address of 119 Listie Street, Irving, Texas. Clemments stated that on November 16, 1964, Riley posted a cash bond of \$37.50 and was not expected to return for trial. He informed that Riley is a cement finisher, working for an unidentified Texas firm at the NASA Test Site, Hancock County, Mississippi, near Picayune. Riley alleged that he temporarily resided at an unidentified motel in Bay St. Louis, Mississippi.
