Based on the information furnished, Bureau files contain no identifiable information concerning [redacted], named in these communications. b7c

Dallas is instructed to conduct an appropriate name check concerning [redacted] and then interview her regarding her statement concerning the assassination. The results of your inquiries along with a true copy of her communication which was addressed to President Johnson should be incorporated in an LHM suitable for dissemination to Secret Service in Dallas and Washington, D.C. b7c

Because of allegations made by [redacted] concerning personnel of the Dallas Police Department, this agency should also be informed. b7c

NOTE: The Justice Department furnished the Bureau a copy of [REDACTED] b7C
a letter addressed to President Johnson written by [REDACTED]
of Dallas. She alleged she has been running for five years because
policemen have been running her from city to city and she wanted
to know if she could file a suit against [REDACTED] b7C
the policemen, who have been "picking at me" for five years.
The Department also furnished a copy of a letter over AAG Miller's
signature which acknowledged her communication which indicated
the Department would be of no assistance to her. Although it b7C
appears that Secret Service may already be aware of [REDACTED] b7C
due to the fact that her letter was addressed to President
Johnson, any additional information developed at Dallas should
be furnished to Secret Service. Dallas Police Department should
also be advised in view of her allegations. From the sound of
her letter, it appears a mental problem may be involved. No
